Holy Trinity Pilgrimage to Ireland & Scotland

12 days / 10 nights

Day 1: Monday, June 25: Depart Home

Our Pilgrimage begins with an overnight flight from Denver, CO to Dublin, Ireland.

Day 2: Tuesday, June 26: Welcome to Ireland

Dublin city tour including O'Connell Street, Phoenix Park, Merrion Square, Trinity College, and Dublin Castle. See the Book of Kells. Celebrate Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes. Dinner and overnight in Dublin.

Day 3: Wednesday, June 27: Wicklow & Glendalough

Drive through Wicklow, home to Powerscourt, and Russborough. Visit Glendalough, where St. Kevin founded a monastery in the 6th century. Celebrate Mass at St. Kevin's Church. Return to Dublin for dinner and overnight.

Day 4: Thursday, June 28: Dublin to Galway

Transfer to Galway, stopping in Bru Na Boinne and Newgrange. Celebrate Mass in Devlin. Dinner and overnight in Galway.

Day 5: Friday, June 19: Galway, Slieve League Cliffs & Donegal

Visit Knock Shrine, an apparition site. Visit Slieve League Cliffs. Dinner and overnight in Derry.

Day 6: Saturday, June 30: Derry to Belfast

Derry city tour including a walk along the walls, the Bogside and Waterside. Visit Giants Causeway. Dinner and overnight in Belfast.

Day 7: Sunday, July 1: Belfast to Glasgow

Belfast city tour including the leaning Albert Memorial Clock tower, the Opera House, City Hall, The Crown Bary, Queens University, Botanic Gardens, Harland and Wolfe Shipyard, and Shankill and Falls road. Take a ferry towards Glasgow. Dinner and overnight in Glasgow

Day 8: Monday, July 2: Glasgow to Oban

Glasgow city tour including Merchant City, the Waterfront, West End, and Dumbarton Castle. Transfer to Oban for dinner and overnight.

Day 9: Tuesday, July 3: Isle of Mull & Iona

Ferry to Craignure and continue to Isle of Iona. Walk past the old nunnery and a historic graveyard. Return to Oban for dinner and overnight.

Day 10: Wednesday, July 4: Oban to Edinburgh

Transfer to Edinburgh, visiting Stirling Castle along the way. Dinner and overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 11: Thursday, July 5: Edinburgh

Edinburgh city tour including Edinburgh Castle, the Honours of Scotland, Royal Scots Regimental Museum, Arthur's Seat, Charlotte Square, the Royal Mile, Sir Walter Scott Monument, St. Andrew Square and St. Giles. Dinner and overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 12: Friday, July 6: Depart for Home

We leave our hotel and head for the Edinburgh airport to return to the US.
